### Peak Closures

As a result of the Holy Fire in the Santa Ana Mountains, access to Modjeska Peak is closed, and Santiago Peak is accessible via the Bedford Truck Trail, or Maple Springs Road, but confusing since the gate at the Main Divide Road is locked and marked "Closed to Entry". ### Climbing Helmet Discussion

From pgs 108-109 of the LRB 18th ed. in the "Safety on Rock" subsection:  
*Participants expect and deserve an adequate margin of safety on climbs sponsored by the Sierra Club. Risk containment is perhaps the leader's most serious responsibility, requiring pre-trip planning, active trip leadership, mountaineering expertise, and mature judgment. For added safety all participants on class 3 and higher terrain when a rope is used or in an area where a significant rockfall hazard is present are required to wear climbing helmets. Some leaders may wish to require helmets on class 3 rock even when a rope will not be used.*

For Five Fingers, Antsell Rock, Lily Rock, and Route 2 of Strawberry Peak; the Committee adopted adding the following language :

"Angeles Chapter policy requires the possession and use of a climbing helmet on Class 3 terrain or where the hazard of rockfall is present." be added to the Peak Guides.

For Galena and Sugarloaf Route 2, The Committee also approved the following language be added to the Peak Guides:

"The Hundred Peaks Section highly recommends the possession and use of a climbing helmet on these routes." (Coby/Aimee/Appvd).
